Build an independent, multi-disciplinary organisation, anchored in the Asia Pacific region, while maintaining cohesion with and relevance to local and global needs and activities

Develop partnerships with policymakers, the affected community and other stakeholders to raise awareness of the health, social and economic impacts of viral hepatitis

Develop research to identify gaps, barriers and policy solutions to increase access to medical care and service delivery in viral hepatitis

Priorities and Activities

- Develop tools to support advocacy initiatives within the region
- Promote policy solutions to relevant decision-makers based on sound research
- Support regional members with tools to assist their advocacy efforts locally

- Build an active presence on World Hepatitis Day 28 July annually
- Develop physician education initiatives with special focus on delivery in resource-poor settings
- Pursue partnerships and collaborations to coordinate actions, share information and build local capacity

- Conduct regional audit to identify barriers to diagnosis, treatment and care
- Identify policy gaps and develop research projects to resolve them
- Examine feasibility of low-cost point-of-care testing with a view to developing pilot model for diagnosis and treatment
